**** 1 Black ****

On the second day, God spoke and said, "I would like some water and some sky"

**** 6 Sky ****

So there was a huge blue sky,

And God was very pleased with what He had made. It was very good!

On the third day, God created dry land and the sea, and put the sky above the earth. He made the land and the sea separate.

**** 9 world ****

He made the round world.

**** 10 ->creation**

seaweed **

Then God said, "Let there be all sorts of plants. Those that flower, those that do not. Those that are small, and those that are big." God created all the green plants. And God was very pleased with what He had made.

**** 18 Good ****

It was very good!

On the fourth day, God said, "Let there be all sorts of lights in the sky"

**** 19 Stars and Planets ****

So God created day time and night time.

**** 20 Moon ****

The stars and the moon and the planets God put in the sky at night-time,

**** 21 Sunshine****

and God put the sun in the sky in the day-time.

**** 22 Good ****

And God was very pleased with what He had made. It was very good!

**** 23 -> starfish ****

On the fifth day, God said, "I want animals and creatures in the sea" and He created all sorts of fishes and creatures that live in the sea.

**** 26 birds ****

God also said, "I would like birds to fly in the sky" So God created all the different sorts of birds to fly in the sky.

**** 27 Good ****

And God was very pleased with what He had made. It was very good!

**** 29 -> Virus bacteria ****

On the sixth day God said, "I would like the earth to be full of all sorts of living creatures. Small animals, big animals, those that walk, those that crawl, those that hop, those that slither, and those that are so small we can not even see them. " So God created all sorts of animals and creatures, and

**** 32 Good ****

God was very pleased with what He had made. It was very good!

God also said, "I would like to see some people in the world. Men and women made like me – people able to enjoy what I have made, people who will love me, and look after this wonderful world."

**** 33 Adam and Eve ****

So God made Adam and Eve – the first people on the beautiful world He had made. He made them to enjoy the world, and to look after the world, and to look after each other as well.

**** 34 Good ****

And God looked at everything that He had made, and He was very pleased with everything – it was all very good!

**** 35 globe ****

God made a beautiful world, with the sky, stars, moon, sun, and the earth with all sorts of amazing animals, birds and creatures.

**** 36 → 37 Photos of people from *your* fellowship ****

He also made us – all of us. None of us are accidents.

Why did God do all that?

God did it because he loves us, and He wanted to show everyone just how much he loves us.

This amazing world is for us to enjoy!
